The Cove, Eleuthera

DESCRIPTION: Travelers to The Cove, Eleuthera are sure to find bliss on this Bahamian island - named by Travel + Leisure as, "The Best Secret Island on Earth." Eleuthera is an unspoiled out-island enclave dotted with swaying palms, turquoise water and secluded white sand beaches. The intimate, 57-room resort offers a selection of stylish and well-appointed accommodations – rooms, suites, villas and cottages. Situated on 40 lush acres, this pristine hideaway features two private entry beaches, a fitness center, open-air sunset bar, a gourmet restaurant and sushi bar. The resort also offers a myriad of activities available on property. From snorkeling, paddle boarding, kayaking and bicycling to more relaxed pursuits such as lounging by the scenic infinity pool, guests at The Cove have a bevy of options at their fingertips.

HISTORY: Named after the Greek word "eleutheros" meaning freedom, Eleuthera is considered the birthplace of the Bahamas since the British settled here in the 1700s. Pineapple farming was (and still is) one of the main industries. The island lies 50 miles east of Nassau, 225 miles southeast of Miami and is 110 miles long and nearly a mile wide. Eleuthera has coasts on the both the Atlantic and Caribbean. The Cove, Eleuthera is located in Gregory Town on the northern end of the island.

GETTING THERE: The Cove, Eleuthera is 30 minutes south of North Eleuthera Airport (ELH), 50 minutes north of Governor's Harbour Airport (GHB), and 70 minutes from Rock Sound International Airport (MYER). Daily commercial flights from Ft. Lauderdale (FLL), Miami (MIA) Atlanta (ATL) and Nassau (NAS) are available.

MEETINGS & EVENTS:

An unforgettable and unique option for group retreats, executive luxury travel meetings and incentive programs, The Cove offers event and meetings spaces spanning from 3,405 square feet indoors to multiple outdoor options.

Facilities range from The Main Building (100 max outdoors and 150 max indoors) comprised of the Freedom Dining Room – the main dining room for The Cove's signature restaurant (66 – 80 max indoors); Freedom Bar – the full service bar inside Freedom restaurant with a sushi bar and 5-

seat sit-up bar (11 – 46 max); Freedom Reception lounge – welcome area of the main building featuring casually elegant décor (20 max indoors); and the private dining area adjacent to Freedom Reception (8 - 16 max). Additionally, this island retreat setting welcomes a variety of celebratory excursions from girls’ and guys’ getaways, to trips commemorating birthdays, anniversaries, babymoos, and other special milestone moments.

Corporate Meetings and Group Retreats – The Cove, Eleuthera has numerous onsite meeting venue options varying from private group dinners on the beach, to theater and banquet style rooms which can hold up to 150 people all complete with dining and beverages to cater to any corporate event.

AREA ATTRACTIONS / ACTIVITIES:

The island of Eleuthera offers a diverse range of unique activities and excursions that guests can embark on from the resort:

- **Harbour Island** – Rated as one of the “Best Bahama Beaches” by Fodors, Frommers, and The Travel Channel, Harbour Island Bahamas is famous for its colorfully painted New England-style architecture and long stretch of perfect pink sand beaches. Approximately 3.5 miles long and only 1.5 miles wide, Harbour Island is located just off of the tip of Eleuthera, separated by a narrow channel.
- **Glass Window Bridge** – One of Eleuthera’s more popular attractions. Many times referred to as the “narrowest place on Earth”, the man-made bridge took the place of naturally formed bridge of rock that was destroyed in a hurricane. From the bridge, you can see a phenomenal contrast between the dark blue Atlantic Ocean churning away and the calm turquoise waters of the Caribbean Sea.
- **The Leon Levy Native Plant Preserve** – A 25-acre site where the primary focus of the Preserve is to raise the awareness of Bahamian plant diversity and bush medicine. It serves as a center for environmental education.
- **Governor’s Harbour** – A gracious seaside town and fishing community of a few hundred residents with a distinctly colonial feel and a tangible expatriate presence.

- **Surfers Beach** – The most well-known surfing beach in the Bahamas. Located a couple of miles south of Gregory Town on the Atlantic side, this beach has a great left break over a deep reef.
- **Hatchet Bay Caves** – A mile long cave filled with stalagmites and stalactites, which will take on the appearance of underground cathedrals in torch light.
- **Gaulding Kay Beach** – Located just a bike ride away from the resort, Gaulding Kay Beach is the perfect location for a daytime excursion. Offering unbeatable snorkeling and calm turquoise Eleuthera also provides gourmet picnic meals guests can take away and enjoy as they soak up the sun on the beach.
- **The Blue Hole** - Also known as “Sapphire Hole”, the blue hole is a geological phenomenon that is actually an underwater sinkhole formed during the last ice age. As the name suggests, the blue hole is a vibrant azure color – a mixture of warm, fresh and sea water, guests can feed and swim with a plethora of fish. Located in a hidden forest, guests will appreciate the lush scenery and the unique experience of swimming in the blue hole.
